

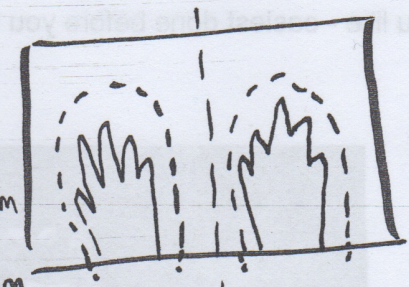
# Content-driven character study with Story Puppets

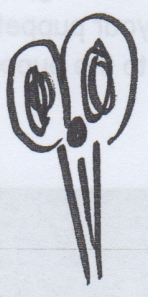

- Story book
- Character sketch (should be able to cover w/ your hand!)
- Felt (1-9"x12" sheet per student) or Burlap (for younger grades)
- Dull Point Metal Embroidery Needles (w/ big eye)
- Embroidery Thread (Prism brand is great - do not buy "Floss")
- Index Cards (cut in 1/4" strips for needle threading trick)
- Scissors (Sharp/big kid kind)
- Markers &/or pastels for dark fabric
- Buttons
- beads
- scrap felt

TIP: USE BOTTOM OF FELT TO MAKE SURE WRIST HAS ROOM

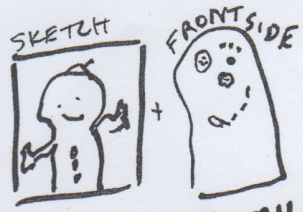
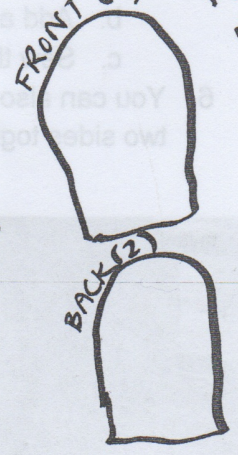


TRACE HAND 2 TIMES  
(around the basic shape not fingers)  
USING MARKER OR PASTEL CHALK



CUT OUT BOTH PIECES USING YOUR LINES

NOTE: KIDS WILL CUT DIFFERENT SIZED FRONTS + BACKS BUT CAN DO THIS & IT WILL BE FINE



ADD DETAILS FROM YOUR SKETCH TO ONE PIECE OF FELT (buttons, beads, thread)



SEW 2 SIDES TOGETHER. DO NOT SEW BOTTOM!  
\*KNOT YOUR ENDS\*



ADD FINAL TOUCHES (felt scraps, fabric, etc.)
